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WHAT IS MAT?

Medications for Addiction Treatment (MAT) is an outpatient, evidence based, whole person program. We help those who are recovering or seeking help to recover from opioid use disorder and other substance use disorders. We offer a variety of tools and a supportive environment to help the person make positive lifestyle changes. Trauma and resilience informed and culturally centered care is at the heart of our MAT program.

MEDICATIONS WE USE

Suboxone is a combination of Buprenorphine and Naloxone. This medication quickly decreases cravings and withdrawal symptoms. Narcan (Naloxone) – an opioid overdose reversal medication.

NARCAN SAVES LIVES!

We also offer other medications for addiction treatment to support and stabilize.

HOW IS OUR PROGRAM STRUCTURED?

- First Visit: After admission, patient will meet with Provider and begin care which will include appropriate medications. Care team will follow-up daily until patient is stable.
- Intake & Assessment: Once comfortable, participant will meet with a member of the MAT Care team for assessment and patientcentered treatment planning.
- Supportive Care: MAT Phases of Care determine frequency of visits.
 - Provider visits.
 - Behavioral Health Care
 - Recovery support includes individual counseling, Cultural needs and group visits.
 - Referral to community based organizations as needed.



OUR MAT PROGRAM IS CULTURALLY-CENTERED

Our recovery care program integrates all cultural needs of every patient from first visit and through out our phases of care. Examples of culturally centered care used by other MAT programs

WHO IS PART OF THE MAT CARE TEAM?

Our MAT Care team is multidisciplinary.

- Primary Care Provider
- Care Coordinator
- Substance Use Counselor
- Behavioral Health Therapist

We meet weekly to support the whole person wellness of each client.
