WHAT IS MAT?

Medications for Addiction Treatment (MAT) is an outpatient, evidence based, whole person program. We help those who are recovering or seeking help to recover from opioid use disorder and other substance use disorders. We offer a variety of tools and a supportive environment to help the person make positive lifestyle changes. Trauma and resilience informed care is at the heart of our MAT program.

MEDICATIONS WE USE

Suboxone is a combination of Buprenorphine and Naloxone. This medication quickly decreases cravings and withdrawal symptoms. Narcan (Naloxone) - an opioid overdose reversal medication.

NARCAN SAVES LIVES

We also offer other medications for addiction treatment to support and stabilize.

HOW IS OUR PROGRAM STRUCTURED?

• First Visit: After admission, patient will meet with Provider and begin care which will include appropriate medications. Care team will follow-up daily until patient is stable.

• Intake & Assessment: Once comfortable, participant will meet with a member of the MAT Care team for assessment and patient-centered treatment planning.

• Supportive Care: MAT Phases of Care determine frequency of visits.

- Provider visits.
- Behavioral Health Care
- Recovery support includes individual counseling and group visits.
- Referral to community-based organizations as needed.

WHO IS PART OF THE MAT CARE TEAM?

Our MAT Care Team is multidisciplinary.

- Primary Care Provider
- Care Coordinator
- Substance Use Counselor
- Behavioral Health Therapist

We meet weekly to support the whole person wellness of each client.
